### POINTS OF INTEREST

- 100** - Walking tour map. Pictures of John Manion, Dr. AT Roos and David Swanzey (1880 Train Depot) Picture of the "Iron Horse" train engine
- 402** - Original building and site of Keystone Volunteer Fire Dept. and Town Hall. (Battle Creek Vacations)
- 529** - Close to original site of Carrie Ingalls house which was destroyed by fire in 1977. (The SoDak Shack LLC)
- 405** - Entering Keystone's original business and mining district, once larger than Rapid City. (Brookside Motel)
- 106** - Memorial dedicated to the flood victims of the June 9th, 1972 Flood. (Dahl's Chainsaw Art)
- 511** - Story and picture of Lakota artist Orville Sr. "Paha Ska" Salway. (Emporium)
- 113** - Ride the 1901 Otis Elevator. It came from the Homestake Gold Mine, and reportedly the first of its kind west of the Mississippi. (Sprockets Fun Foundry)
- 605** - Keystone Visitor Information Center Commemorating the anniversary of the 1972 Flood.
- 611** - Keystone City Park and City Hall : Walking Tour Map and Fitness Walk Map. Veterans Memorial by Picnic Shelter
- 523** - Slaughter House Mountain: Pictures of Mt. Rushmore workers. (Mt. Rushmore T-Shirts)
- 317** - Picture of Borglum's 1st studio and the Crag of Jesse T information. (Red's Chicken House and BBQ)
- Mountain View Cemetery** This U.S. Forest Service land was deeded to Modern Woodmen of America by President Theodore Roosevelt in 1900.
- 109** - Site of area's first gift shop, history of Golden Valley and the Hesnard Museum. (National Presidential Wax Museum)
- 107** - Site of 1930's baseball field for Rushmore Memorial drillers and picture of the baseball team.
- Original site of a powder house** which stored blasting powder and bootleg liquor. Also, near site of what was called Crossville circa 1877.
- 318** - Pictures of Wild Horse Harry Hardin, Old Dave McVay and Harney Hydraulic Gold Mining Co. Trestle. (Ruby House)
- 813** - Settled as a gold camp in 1876. Former seat of Custer County. (Rushmore Cave)

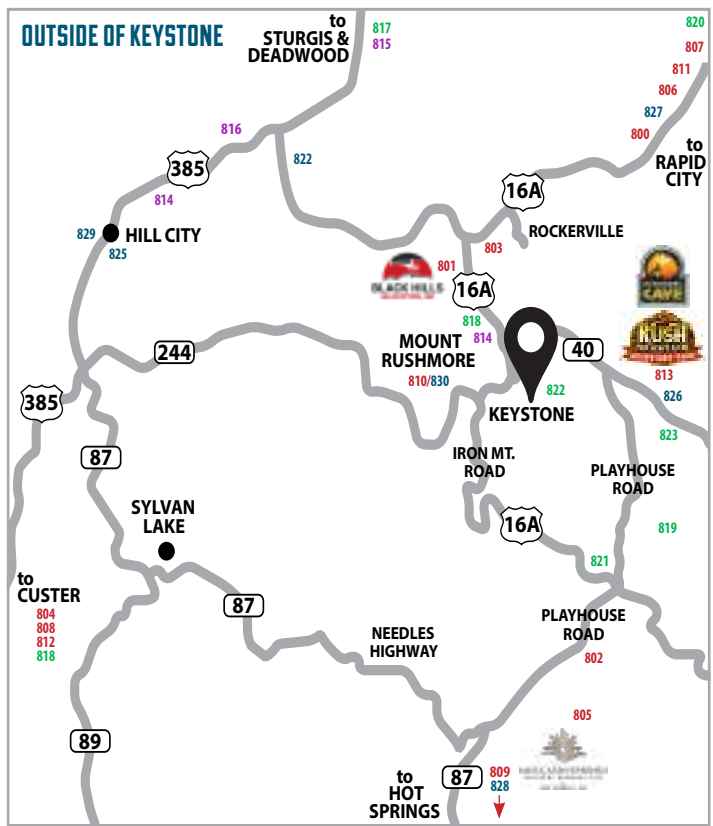
